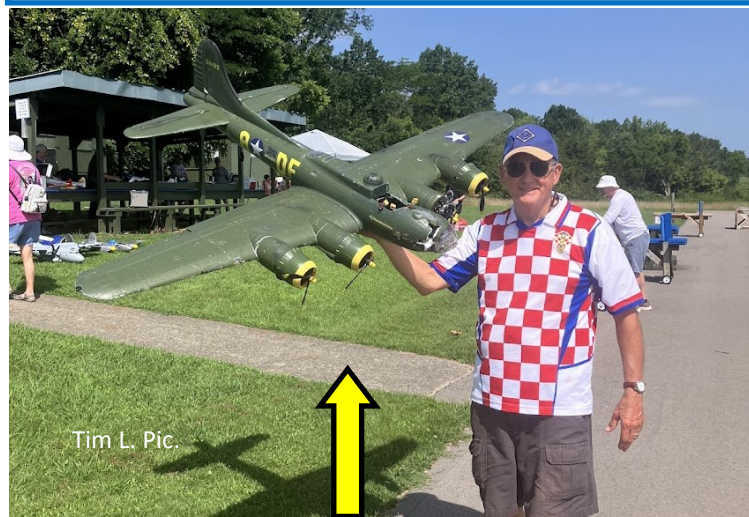
We are proud of our new blue shelter that is 10 by 20. It makes a great place to relax and watch the flying during our events.

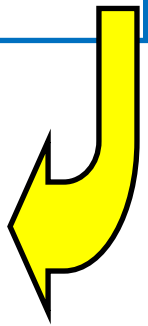
