MTRCS Treasurer's Corner October 1, 2025

2025 has been an excellent year for our Club. Membership is now at 149 active members. We were provided two (2) grants from the Academy of Model Aviation (AMA) for our airfield improvements, being a leader within the area to promote model aviation and supporting our community's youth programs thru the Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts. Through your hard work we have brought our airfield back to life with painting, upkeep, installing new test stands, upgrading our work benches, shelving in our shed for proper storage of training aircraft and overall groundskeeping. We as members of MTRCS have a lot to be proud of.

We are now adding to our website the information to purchase MTRCS merchandise. Your order can even be personalized for what you want to say. With our vendor we do not tie up funds in inventory, and we profit 7% of sales.

As Treasurer, I have closely monitored our funds, fundraising, and this year's major expenditure.

Within the framework of revenue, I, along with the approval of the officers, have removed the option of payment by PayPal. The reason for this decision is that PayPal charges \$2.46 per \$30.00 payment. It also takes PayPal 3-5 business days to transfer the funds to our bank. This is over \$366.54 less revenue from 149 members. You still have the option to pay in cash, check and now Zelle (QR code is on our website). With Zelle there are no surcharges and they are directly deposited in our bank account.

The dues for **2026** are now due to start on **November 1, 2025**. When making your payment please ensure you provide your latest address, contact number, email address, AMA Number and AMA expiration date of membership. I will ensure that all this information is secure within our database. I will acknowledge receipt of your funds via your email address so that you have confirmation of dues paid in full for 2026.


Whitney Philbrick and his son fly a lot together. They fly mostly big planes and you will see them flying at the Music City War Bird and Classic this weekend.
