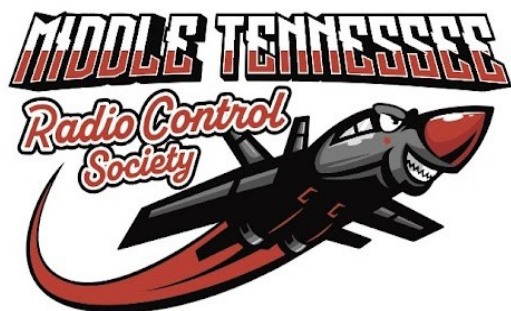




NEWSLETTER November, 2025
